Spring ISD Radio Frequency Identification Badge Policy

Each student will be issued a Photo RFID at the beginning of the school year or when they enroll at ***no additional charge***. The student is required to wear the ID badge on the outside of the clothing or according to your school policy. The ID badges are to be worn on the bus, to school and to school activities that take place during the school day, per our 2009-2010 student ID badge policy. The Photo ID will be required for a student to check materials out of the school library, to access food services in the cafeteria, to board a school bus, and for admission to all school activities.

Discipline consequences may be assigned to students not wearing their Photo ID or for intentional damaging their ID badge. A student's ID badge must be maintained in the same condition as issued or the student will be required to purchase a new one.

A replacement fee of \$15 will be charged for lost or damaged identification tags. All schools must pay for additional ID badges after the initial badges are purchased and distributed. Schools will be accountable for maintaining adequate records for ID badges.
